I. Plan vour life

Eph. 5:15 Look carefully **then** how you walk, not as unwise but as wise,

Psa. 90:10 The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty; yet their span is but toil and trouble; they are soon gone, and we fly away.

Psa. 90:12 So <u>teach us to number our days</u> that we may get a heart of <u>wisdom</u>.

Psa. 90:17 Let **the favor of the Lord our God** be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, **establish the work of our hands!**

II. Manage your time

Eph. 5:16 making the best use of the time, because the days are evil.

- Determine the areas of your calling work, family, church & personal life.
- 2. Divide the negotiable and non-negotiable aspects of your calling
- 3. Schedule in the non-negotiable aspects of your callings.
- 4. Wisely determine which negotiable aspects of your callings will be scheduled in.
- 5. Have a sense of calling in each moment as you live in different areas of your calling.
